TASTING NOTES:

The Tench Vineyard, EE, Red Wine is 65% Cabernet, 30% Cabernet Franc and 5% Petit Verdot, and the blend gives us another layer of complexity and sophistication. This wine is suave and dapper... think Mr. Darcy in a bottle.
