TASTING NOTES

Our 2020 Napa Valley Cabernet opens with fresh fruit, aromas of black currant, ripe raspberry, wild sage, graphite, crushed rose petals, and fennel seed. The pallet is elegant, complex, rich, and refreshing with a long finish that is supported by supple tannin and beautifully integrated French Oak.

WINEGROWING NOTES

This wine incorporates choice fruit from vineyards throughout Napa Valley—from small rugged hillside sites of our partner growers to each of our organic estate vineyards. By blending these various lots, we create a rich panorama on the palate, a landscape of complexity and character that depicts Napa Valley.

VINTAGE NOTES

The winter of 2020 was warm and dry, setting off budbreak and the growing season slightly earlier than usual throughout Napa Valley. It wasn't until the end of March that cold, rainy weather arrived, and the mild spring gave the vines a strong, early start. Moderately warm days held through the summer and early fall, allowing the fruit to ripen slowly and develop complex flavor and tannin balance, while maintaining fresh acidity. This vintage produced great wines that are concentrated, focused, and beautifully balanced.
