Vida Valiente 's Estate Vineyard was planted on virgin soil in 2018 to four clones of Cabernet Sauvignon. Located at the base of Glass Mountain in St. Helena the striking Cortina soil series - extremely well drained cobbled rock and sand - yields wines of remarkable structure.

Just the second vintage from this singular site, the result is a dynamic and heady expression of Cabernet Sauvignon that brings the entire picture together in perfect harmony. Gothic in the glass, dark raspberries, Santa Rosa plums, wild blueberries, wet stone, menthol, truffle, and incense lead into an unctuous palate full of minerals, decadent fruit, and crushed stones. Lusciously ripe and grainy tannins provide endless layers of terroir-driven nuance, while the bold freshness supports the tightly wound layers of fruit and rocks.

The Movement is a meticulously crafted blend of the best Cabernet Sauvignon lots from all of Vida Valiente 's vineyard sources. The Estate, Graveside, and Beckstoffer To Kalon all contribute their unique traits for a harmonious and expressive Cabernet Sauvignon.

Focused, expressive, and precise, a classic bouquet of black cherries, blackberry compote, blueberries, crème de cassis, pencil shavings and currants emerge from the glass, only to be followed by seductive layers of leather, truffle, tobacco leaf, savory herbs, and exotic spices. A fluid fruit-laced energy is enveloped by waves of volcanic minerals, all framed by garnet acidity and a plush, velvety texture.

2022 Beckstoffer To Kalon Vineyard

Winemaker's Notes

Sourced from the newest redeveloped block of this Oakville vineyard icon, the youthful exuberance of the fruit is matched only by the intimate knowledge and legacy possessed by this site's fabled soil. Our second vintage from this block highlights the wine's magnificent pedigree, bringing new life and vision to this already heralded plot of Grand Cru dirt. It's western bench land terroir is riddled with bale clay and loam, interwoven with ancient tributaries of rock that meander effortlessly through the landscape.

These well-draining soils produce Cabernet Sauvignon that beams with a refined and elegant precision.Invigorating notes of cassis, wild blueberries, tobacco, gravelly loam and pencil shavings lead into a voluptuous palate brimming with spiced fruits, toffee, and a magnificent texture. The mid-palate is framed perfectly by the wine 's vibrant acidity and fruit-forward tannins, all culminating in a lengthy finish that is the epitome of power and grace.

2022 Graveside Vineyard

Winemaker's Notes

Situated on western boundary of the St. Helena appellation, the Graveside Vineyard finds itself surrounded by some of Napa Valley's most hallowed sites. Developed by Jim Barbour in 2015 to three distinct clones, the combination of alluvial rock and sand lends itself to being a perfect resting place for growing world-class Cabernet Sauvignon.

Perched on the edge of Sulphur Spring Creek, this rocky vineyard lurks in the afternoon shadows of the Mayacamas, where cooler temperatures allow the fruit to ripen slowly, producing fabulous phenolic complexity and an underbelly of expressive and vibrant acidity.

Our 2022 Graveside emerges from the bottle with a brooding and powerful identity, as evocative aromas of wet stone, graphite, candied violets, underbrush and spiced black fruits make their presence known. The ethereal palate is plush with layers of wild black raspberries, currant, and subtle hints of chocolate, giving way to mineral-driven tannins that frame the wine's exquisite and sophisticated personality.
