Tasting Notes: On the nose, this wine presents a captivating bouquet of violet, plum, currant, and blackberry, complemented by subtle hints of black pepper and tobacco leaf. On the palate, it mirrors the aromatic profile, delivering rich flavors of plum, currant, and blackberry. As the tasting progresses, deeper notes of cocoa and black pepper emerge, adding complexity. The wine features ripe, silky tannins and a vibrant backbone of acidity,

Reviewer's Comments: The 2022 Cabernet Sauvignon is deep garnet-purple colored. Notes of baked red currants, fresh blackberries, and raspberry coulis jump from the glass, followed by hints of dried herbs, graphite, and lavender. The medium to full-bodied palate has vibrant red berry and savory flavors with a grainy texture and lovely tension, finishing with a minty lift.
